Old Vine Garnacha of Calatayud



Ateca Winery is a project of the famed Gil Family, founded in 2005 in Calatayud DO. Ateca wines are the result of a detailed work on selecting the grape, with exhaustive analytical and organoleptic quality criteria, coming from a harvest done in the precise moment of ripening. The Australian enologist Michael Kyberd is the technical director.

The treasure of Bodegas Ateca is its 85 hectares of old Garnacha vines, with an average age of more than fifty years, that grow on the slopes of the mountains of this town. The vineyard, planted in slate-based soils in the places of higher altitude of the area, consist of small parcels of old Grenache vines, some of them dated from the early 20th Century.


Honoro Vera: fermentation in stainless steel then aged in French oak barrels for two months.

Atteca: fermentation in stainless steel then aged in French oak barrels for ten months.

Atteca Armas: fermentation in stainless steel then aged in French oak barrels for eighteen months.

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
